Contest Rules

1. All players to be registered with the British Brass Band Registry or other recognised registry.
2. It is the band responsibility to ensure that Registration cards of all players are complete in every detail including FRANKING for the current Year.
3. NWCBBBA rules apply in their most current form. *None NWCBBBA Bands may request a full set of rules.*
4. **Temporary Day Transfers.**
Application may be made on the official form and presented at the Registration Desk.
A maximum of 5 players from the same or lower section.
Section Four may borrow a max. of three (3) players from the Third Section as part of their five borrowed players.
5. Objections or Complaints must be submitted in writing within THREE days after the Contest accompanied with a fee of £10. The fee will be refunded if the objection is upheld. **The Contest Managements decision is final.**
6. Prize Money will be withheld until all registration problems and pending objections are cleared.
7. The Management reserves the right to alter Prize Money, or cancel any section, or cancel the contest according to entries.
8. Bands not ready to pay within 5 minutes of the previous Band can be disqualified.
9. A Band consists of 25 brass players and percussionist as required.
10. Interpretation of all the rules will be the prerogative of the Contest management.

Youth Band Rules

1. Adjudication will be 'Open'.
2. No points will be awarded.
3. All Bands will receive an Adjudicator's report.
4. First 3 placed Bands will be announced.
5. All Bands will receive a commemorative Certificate.
6. Band Members should be aged **19** or under.
7. All players should be *bona fide members* of the Band.
8. A player may play with more than one Band providing they are members of the Band.
9. Bands may use four 'Tutors' these people must be *bona fide tutors* to the Band they are playing with.

*Please do not abuse these few simple rules,
with young people the main aim is to give them experience,
winning is not the only end game.*
